NOTICE OF AVAILABILITY

An Individual Environmental Report (IER) #28 (IER #28), titled Government Furnished Borrow Material #4, prepared by the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, New Orleans District, is available for your review. This notice is being posted per alternative NEPA arrangements implemented on March 12, 2007.

The purpose of the proposed action discussed in IER #28 is to acquire suitable borrow material for levee and floodwall projects in the New Orleans Metropolitan Area. The proposed action consists of excavating material from borrow areas in Plaquemines and St. Bernard Parishes, and to approve for use an access road for an approved borrow area in Jefferson Parish. The borrow material would be used to rebuild and complete construction of the Greater New Orleans Hurricane and Storm Damage Risk Reduction System.
