Corps reschedules lower-Plaquemines Parish public meeting to Jan. 28

NEW ORLEANS, LA – The public meeting that the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers is hosting to discuss the proposed action to reduce risk to residents of lower Plaquemines Parish has been rescheduled from Jan. 14 to **Jan. 28, 2009**.

The meeting will be an opportunity to address the proposed action to upgrade the current West bank Plaquemines Parish Non-Federal Levee as it will be discussed in a Supplemental Environmental Impact Statement which will be available for public review in spring 2009.
